What to Bring: The following list is by no means complete. Pack whatever you feel you need to bring to be comfortable for two days.

1. Pillow
2. Linen (bed and pillow + light blanket) **Note:** All rooms are air-conditioned.
3. Towels
4. Toilet Kit
5. 1 to 2 uniforms
6. Several T-shirts
7. Couple pairs of Shorts
8. Bathing suit
9. Sneakers
10. Bug Spray or Lotion
11. Sun Screen
12. Personal Water Bottle **Note:** We will provide water but you need to bring your own water bottle.
13. Flash Light
14. Personal Medicine (if applicable)
15. Personal Snacks and Beverages
16. Weapons (staff, kama, Tonfa, knife, & cane if you have one and sword depending on rank)

Note: If you own short sticks (kali/escrima), please bring them.

17. Light jacket (waterproof in case of rain)
18. Socks and underwear
19. Notebook and pen or pencil

Directions: Camp ASCCA are both conveniently located within 100 miles of one-half of Alabama's population.

Camp ASCCA is located off U.S. 280 in Jackson's Gap between Dadeville and Alexander City. Turn off U.S. 280 at Jackson's Gap; follow the Camp ASCCA signs to the main entrance of Camp ASCCA Drive. From there follow the Black Belt Camp signs to the camp office. Please note that the Camp ASCCA Drive is a very long and yet well-paved road!

From Atlanta – Take 1-85 south to U.S. 280 West, exit number 58 (Please note it is the second exit!) towards Opelika. Keep right at the fork in the ramp. Merge onto Gateway Drive. Gateway Drive becomes U.S. 280 West. Estimated time from Atlanta is 2 and half to 3 hours maximum.

From Lake Worth – Take 1-95 to I –10 West. Take I-75 North to I-475 North. Merge onto I-75 and take the I-285 bypass. Take I-85 South to Columbus/Montgomery. Take U.S 280 West (exit number 58 – second exit towards Opelika). Follow the directions above to Camp ASCCA. Estimate travel time from Jacksonville is 8 to 9 hours.

From Montgomery – See Master Coker for specific directions from Montgomery to Camp ASCCA

From Bogalusa – See Master Busby for specific direction from Bogalusa to Camp ASCCA

From South Carolina – Drive from South Carolina to Atlanta and follow the directions above.
